## Healthcare/Hospital Disability Awareness Training Debuted at Niagara Falls Memorial



Niagara University's Disability Awareness Training has completed Phase One of its Healthcare/Hospital training on February 23. Project Director Dave Whalen trained the full administrative team at the **Niagara Falls Memorial Medical Center**.

NFMMC received a \$3.5 million grant from the **Thomas B. Golisano Foundation** to establish a **Developmental Disabilities clinic**. The clinic, the only of its kind in Western New York, will serve individuals across the DD spectrum.

The Train the Trainer will be conducted on March 16-17, with the ultimate goal of training all 1,100 employees of the center.

## NYS Department of Health Traumatic Brain Injury Unit Funds Video & Training

**New York State Department of Health Traumatic Brain Injury** has funded NU FRDAT to provide a Firefighter/EMS Train the Trainer with an emphasis on Traumatic Brain Injury. The program will be conducted on May 10-11 in East Greenbush, NY.



This funding will also support the development of a video featuring **Brent Feuz**, a TBI survivor and former firefighter/EMT. Brent is the author of "A Guide to Approaching Mild/Moderate Brain Injury in New York State."

NU is excited to expand its TBI educational materials in conjunction with the State of New York and Mr. Feuz.
