NU FRDAT to Debut in Arkansas

Project Director Dave Whalen will travel to **East Camden, Arkansas** next week to debut the Law Enforcement and Firefighter/EMS Disability Awareness Train the Trainer programs. Arkansas is the second state after New York to fully fund the First Responder Disability Awareness Training project. The NU FRDAT office and **Arkansas Governor's Developmental Disabilities Council** are very excited to launch the program in their state.



NU FRDAT will return in the winter for a second round of Fire/EMS and LE trainings and also to debut the 911 Train the Trainer as well. See training schedule below for training dates.

Progress Report



NU FRDAT and the United States Department of Justice Community Relations Service are close to finalizing a law enforcement disability awareness training specific to intellectual disabilities and autism.

- Project Director Dave Whalen continues discussions with the New York State Justice Center on expanded training opportunities for law enforcement. NU FRDAT is also exploring having the Center's training academy become the Eastern hub for DAT.

- The EMS Disability Awareness Online Training is under review by the Center for Healthcare Education. CHE will be giving feedback and vetting the program.

- The 911 Dispatch Disability Awareness Train the Trainer is under review by the National Emergency Numbers Association. NENA and NU FRDAT are in discussion on how to bring the program across the country.
